

NURSERY | COVID PRECAUTIONS

We at Chapel Grace want to do our best to serve you and your family's needs while ensuring your child's safety. We have put these additional temporary policies into place as precaution because of Covid-19. All other nursery policies will continue to apply. If you have any questions please ask a nursery attendant.

1. There will be a total cap to 12 children in our nursery. The group of 12 children will be separated into smaller groups to accommodate the size of the rooms. The smaller front room will have no more than 4 children and 2 attendants. The larger back room will have no more than 8 children and 2 attendants. This will be a first come first serve basis. Once capacity is reached there will be no more admittance.
2. Before children and nursery attendants are permitted to come into the nursery area they must pass a questionnaire about their health in the past two weeks and have their temperatures checked. If there are any concerning answers on the questionnaire or the child or nursery attendant temp is over 100.4 they will not be permitted entry to the area.
3. All attendants and children will be asked to sanitize or wash hands upon entering the area.
4. All of the nursery's paid staff and volunteers will be required to wear face coverings at all times. They will also be required to wear gloves while serving any type of food or beverage.
5. Children are not required to wear a mask, but if they are above the age of 2 they are highly encouraged. If you ask the attendant to have your child wear a mask they will make sure your child wears it at all times with the exemption of while they are eating or drinking.
6. Food and beverages will now come in individual containers or pre-portioned packaging. Also all children will be asked to wash or sanitize their hands before and after meals.
7. Nursery areas will be sanitized in between services on Sundays and after each use with the use of a sanitizing mister and all surfaces will be wiped down with a disinfectant.
8. We will do our best to have children stay at least 3 feet apart and not share items. We will modify meal times so they are appropriately spaced at the table. However there will be times where children who want to share a toy or an area with one another and will inevitably be using the same items or sharing the same space. We sanitize items as we see fit, and do our best to keep children socially distanced.
9. If someone has a positive covid test all attendants and parents will be immediately notified. If your child displays any symptoms within 2 weeks after attending the nursery please call the Chapel Grace office at (559) 935-0734 to notify us. Anyone who has tested positive may return to after they have had clearance from a doctor or 14 days of no symptoms. Chapel Grace is in no way responsible for your child or any attendants becoming ill while attending or working the nursery.
